Building Strong Foundations

Tickle and Touch

Babies' senses are more alert in the infant years than they will ever be again. Babies feel things more distinctly, hear things more loudly, and smell things more intensely. This sensory awareness allows babies to receive an abundant amount of information so they are able to build a foundation for future learning.



Objectives:
D.1.a. Uses senses to investigate environment to discover what objects and people do, how things work, how they can make things happen.
D.4.a. Cries, giggles, laughs when caregiver plays gently with them.

Keep a turkey baster by the diaper-changing area. Use the baster to apply tiny puffs of air to a baby's hands or feet. Show a baby how you squeeze the top of the baster to create the air. On another day, use a feather to tickle a baby's hands and feet.

L15 Language Development 3-6 months

Is That Me?

Little ones need validation that they are repeating accurately the sounds they hear around them. Hearing the sounds they make allows them to adjust and refine their wiring for language.



Objectives:
C.1.a. Listens with interest to language of others.
C.1.c. Attends to language spoken around them.

Baby's babbling and cooing and then recording back to her. She will delight in her familiar sounds in the same way you feel delight when you take their photos from the photos in them.

P14 Physical Development 3-6 months

Scrunchie Watch

At 3-4 months, babies discover their hands. They are also now able to discriminate three colors—red, blue and green.



Objectives:
A.2.a. Shakes or wiggles arms and legs.
A.2.b. Looks at and follows faces and objects with eyes.

Place a red, blue or green scrunchie on a baby's wrist to encourage him to move his hands in front of his face to see the colorful bangles. Make sure the scrunchie fits loosely but not so loose that it comes off easily.

Safety Warning: Supervise closely to make sure the scrunchie doesn't come off the baby's wrist. Place a pillow under the baby's feet so that when he reaches forward or sits up, his head won't be too far off the floor. After a while he may kick just to feel the pillow. Remove pillow when play is over.

SE16 Social Emotional Development 3-6 months

You Are My Sunshine

Singing is a great way to share joy with the little ones in your care. Singing helps calm children, it helps develop their language skills, it reduces their stress. Sing often. Pretend you are starting in a musical and a baby is your co-star.



Objectives:
A.1.d. Begins to demonstrate healthy and safe habits.
E.1.b. Shows social interaction with a smile and mutual eye gaze.
C.1.a. Enjoys an adult's singing.

Sing "You Are My Sunshine" (Frog Street Baby Songs CD). Sing along with the CD and then sing the song again without the CD. Babies need to hear your voice and see your mouth move in order to develop language. Sing some of your favorite songs to babies.

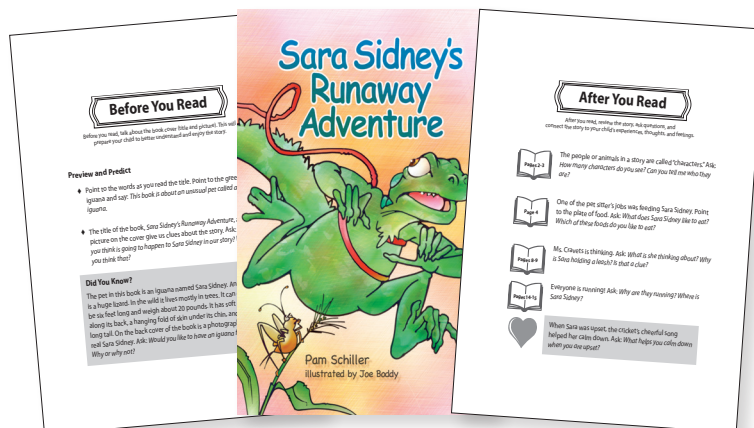

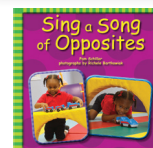

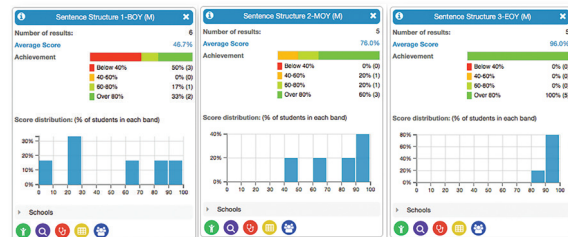
